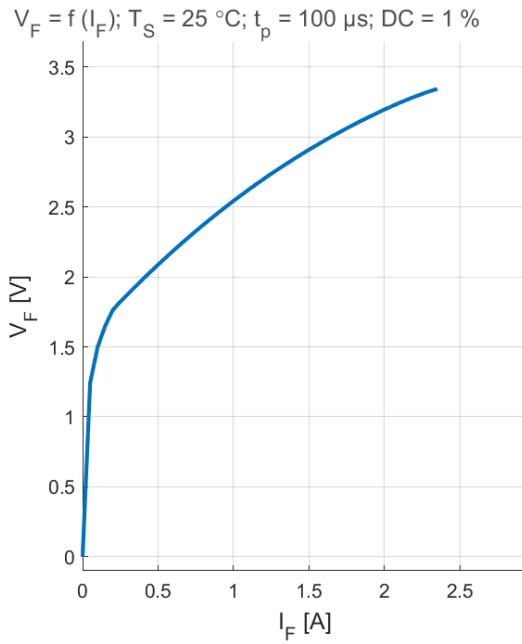

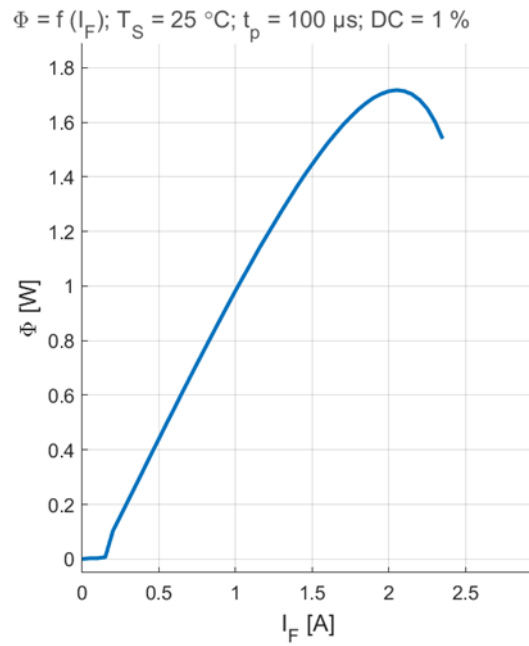

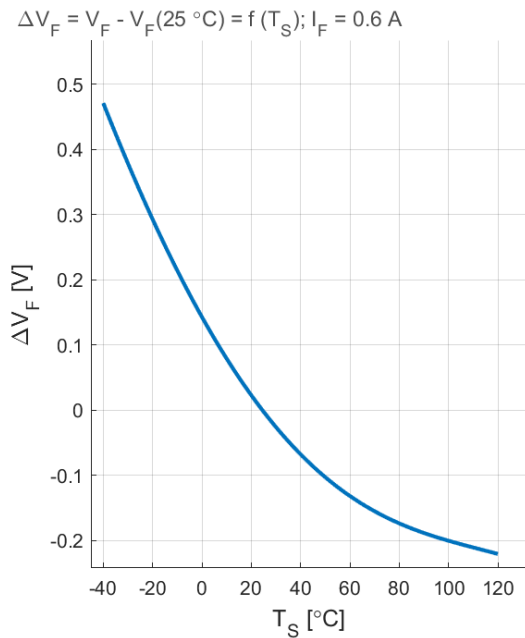
Forward Voltage ^{1) 2)}



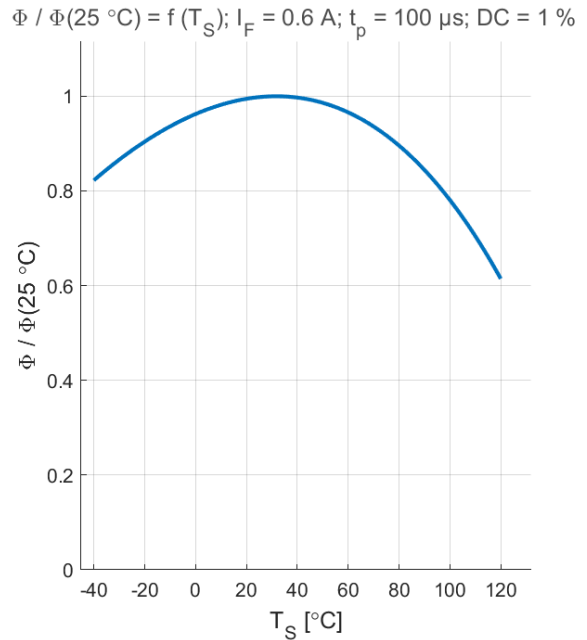
Optical Output Power ^{1) 2)}



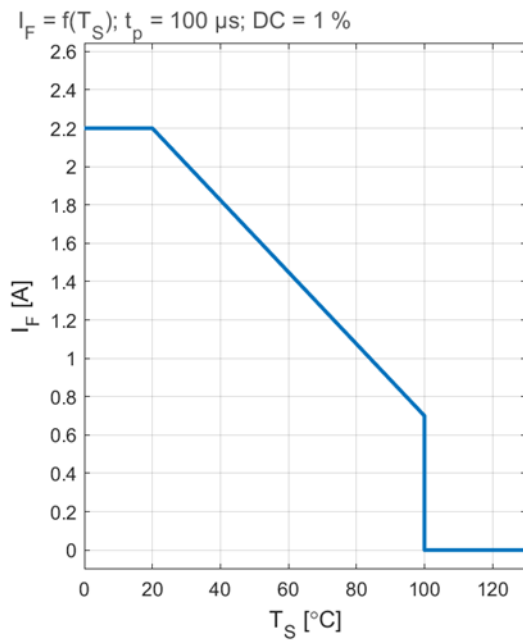
Relative Forward Voltage ¹⁾



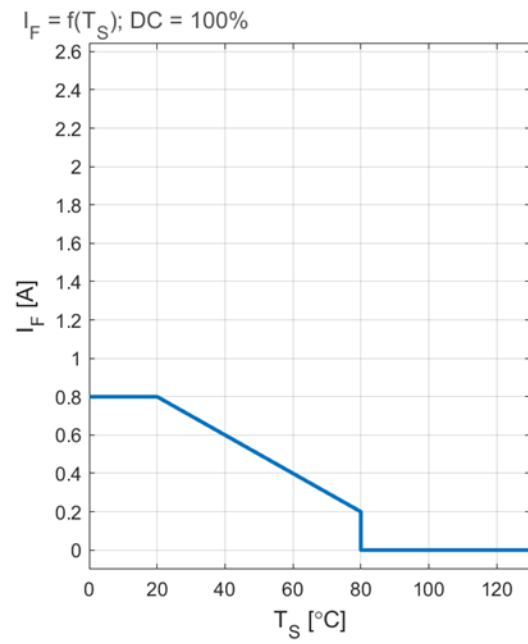
Relative Radiant Power ¹⁾



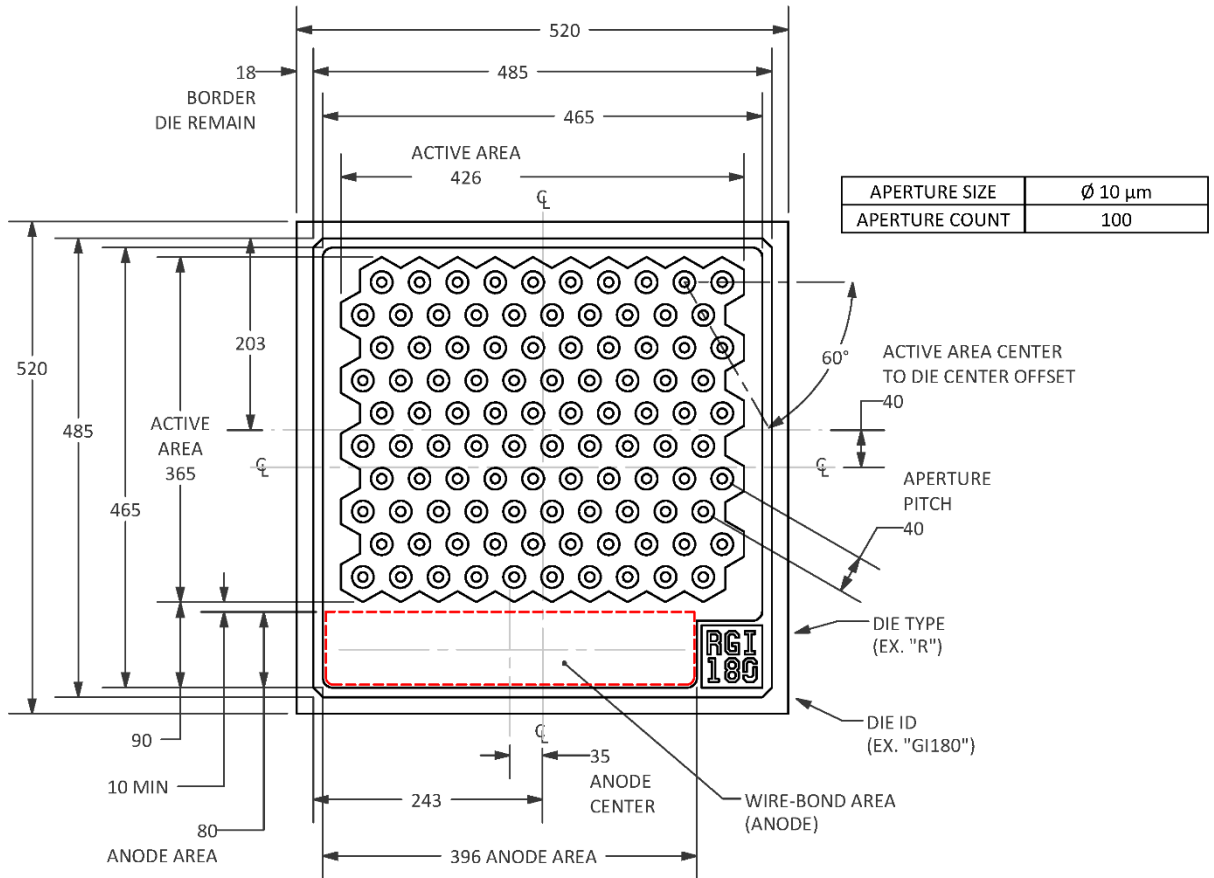
Max Permissible Pulse Current



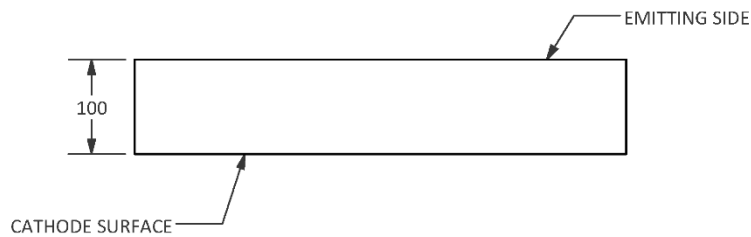
Max Permissible Current
